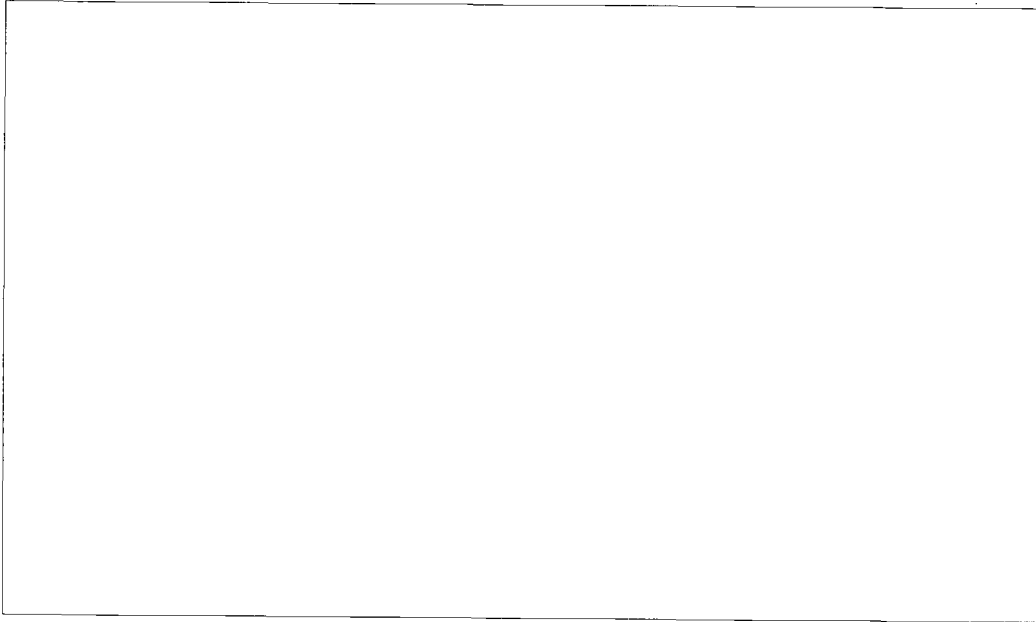

North Korean and Chinese Communist prisoners taken since late February have reported over-hearing or being told that a great quantity of air, armor, and artillery support was being assembled in Manchuria to be sent into Korea to support a coming major offensive. Estimates varied from 4,000 aircraft and 3,000 tanks to a vague reference to a "large number of tanks, artillery and 400 aircraft to be received in time for the 'May offensive.'" [Redacted]

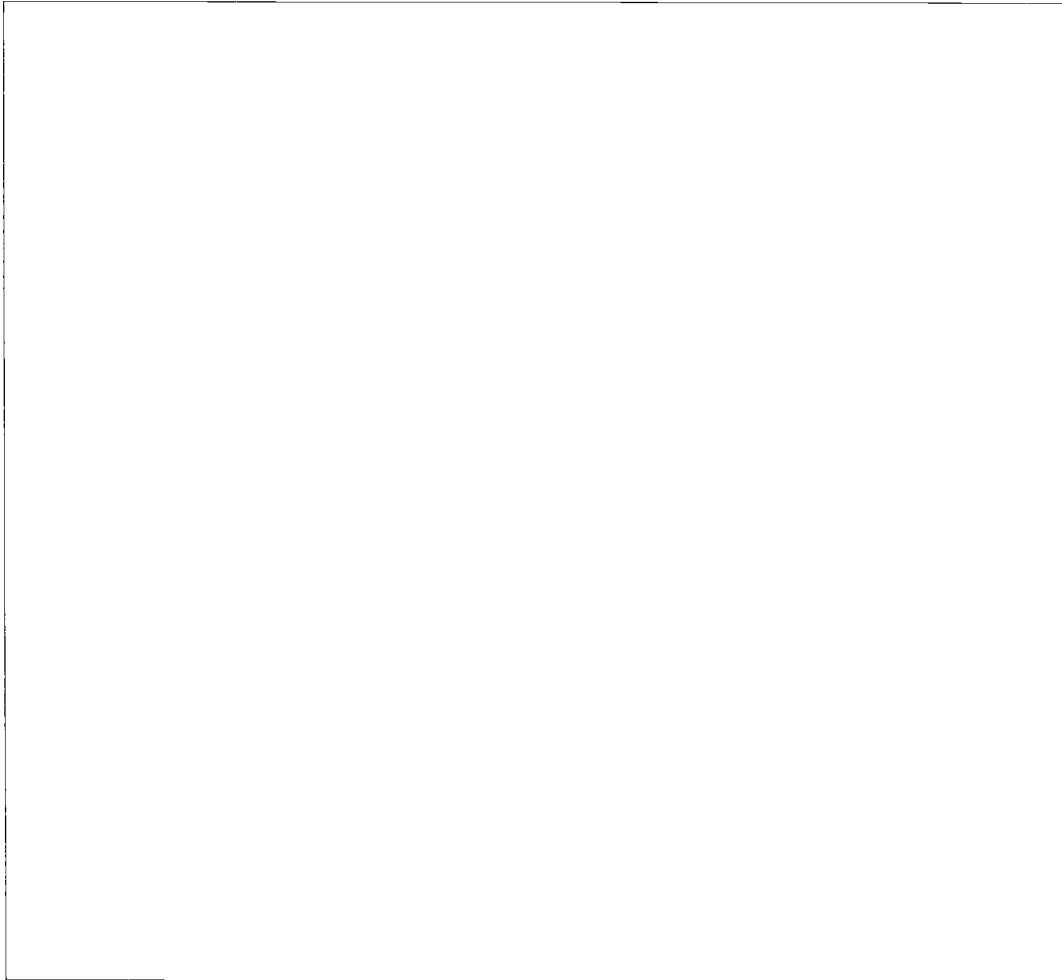
